INSTRUCTIONS

One week before your procedure:

- Hold ALL acid suppressing medications (omeprazole/Prilosec/pantoprazole/Zantac/ranitidine, etc.)
- Use Tums or Maalox extremely sparingly (best if avoided all together)
- Hold all diet pills (i.e.- phentermine)
- Check with your prescribing doctor to make sure it is safe to hold prescription blood thinners _____
_____ for ____ days.
- Aspirin and Plavix can be taken until the day of the procedure.

1 day prior to the procedure:

- Hold Carafate/sucralafate

Day of the Procedure:

- Hold aspirin and Plavix
- Take any heart, blood pressure or seizure medications in the early morning with a sip of water.
- Hold all other medications the day of the procedure.
- If your procedure is scheduled before noon, nothing to eat or drink after midnight other than seizure or blood pressure medication.
- If your procedure is scheduled after noon, you may have water 6 hours prior to your procedure time
- You will need a driver after your procedure as you will receive sedation. Someone will need to stay with you 12 hours after the procedure.
- No work, driving, operating machinery or making legal decision for 24 hours after procedure
- No smoking the day of the procedure.

During the Study:

- Hold all acid suppressing medications during the study (two days)

If you feel you cannot hold any of the above medications, contact our office.
